### CHAPTER 1 – STANDARD REQUIREMENTS

#### 1.1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

The event shall be known as “2016 HQ NATIONALS”, to be held on 5 & 6 November 2016 at Wakefield Park Raceway, Goulburn, NSW.

#### 1.2 ORGANISATION AND STATUS

The event shall be held under the International Sporting Code of the Federation Internationale de l'automobile (FIA), the National Competition Rules of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Limited (CAMS), the Race Meeting Standing Regulations published by CAMS, the Australian HQ Nationals Sporting Regulations as approved by CAMS, these Supplementary Regulations and any further Regulations and instructions to competitors that may be issued.

### 1.5 ENTRIES

**Opening Date:** Monday 12<sup>th</sup> September 2016      **Closing Date:** Friday 21<sup>st</sup> October 2016

- 1.5.1 **All entries must be completed via the CAMS members' portal on the home page of the CAMS website: ([www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au)).** Competitors should be aware there has been some minor changes in the operation of the website. Entries must be received by the closing date above. Any late entries will be at the discretion of the promoter. Please note that no paper entries will be accepted for this race meeting.
- 1.5.2 If the number of entries received exceeds the maximum number of competitors as per these regulations the organiser reserves the right to accept those entries which it deems suitable.
- 1.5.3 Entry Fee is \$570.00 for this race meeting including GST.
- 1.5.4 The organisers reserve the right to accept or reject entries at their sole discretion without assigning reason, in accordance with the NCR's.
- 1.5.5 Provided the competitor has notified of withdrawal in writing seven days prior to the meeting, the entry fee, less a \$50 administration fee, will be credited.
- 1.5.6 Competitors will not be considered entered until full payment of entry fees and garage fees (where applicable) are cleared funds.

## **1.7 PRACTICE/QUALIFYING AND RACING**

Practice/Qualifying and race distances will be advised in the Sporting Regulations.

## **1.9 LICENCE REQUIREMENTS**

1.9.1 Competitors in this event must hold a minimum of a CAMS Provisional Clubman Circuit (PCC) Licence (or superior) and be a member of a CAMS-Affiliated Car Club.

## **1.10 CHANGE OF DRIVER**

Change of driver is permitted at this event as per the General Competition rules.

## **1.11 AUTOMATIC TIMING**

The organisers utilise the automatic Dorian timing system, which requires all cars to be fitted with a Dorian transmitter, which is the competitor's responsibility. Hiring Dorian transmitter can be done through Eldee Timing – 0413055114. Bookings are essential as there is limited supply.

## **1.12 PRACTICE AVAILABILITY**

**Official Practice will be available on Friday 4th November 2016**

The cost of the Official Practice day is \$150.00 per driver (you need to pre-enter via the CAMS online entry system). Further unofficial practice is available on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> November, which is an open Test & Tune day at Wakefield Park. Again, the fee for this day is \$150.00 full day or Half-day practice is available for \$75 per driver for drivers who sign on after 12:30pm. All drivers must present their valid competition licence in person to sign on in the admin office.

## **1.13 GARAGE AND PADDOCK ALLOCATION**

Garage and Carport allocation will be done on a first in first served basis;  
Garages - \$250 (inc GST) per bay. 67 Available (30 pit lane and 37 paddock garages).  
Paddock Carports – \$150 (inc GST) per bay. 60 Available  
Allocation will be done following close of entries and allocated in order of receipt of entries.

## **1.14 ADMISSION TO CIRCUIT**

Competitors will be issued with 4 competitor passes per vehicle entered. The competitor admission passes are the identification required for access to the marshalling area and signalling areas. There will be no refund for persons having to pay at the gate. Additional passes can be purchased at \$20 (GST inc) at the gate. Persons not presenting a ticket will be required to pay the normal admission charges.

## **1.15 SCRUTINY**

All vehicles must be in the CAMS targeted scrutiny system but competitors are encouraged to review the 'HQ Nationals Sporting Regulations' so as to ensure their vehicle is compliant for this event.

**1.16 PROTESTS**

Protests shall be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

**1.17 POSTPONEMENT, ABANDONMENT OR CANCELLATION**

Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

**1.18 USE OF PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES**

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

**1.19 VEHICLE SIGNAGE**

In light of our commercial commitments to sponsors, competitors are requested to ensure that windscreen banners are able to be installed both front and rear on their vehicles as well as front and rear number plate spots.
